NOTICE OF MOTION From Councillor Rory Francis: "Climate and nature crisis Ffestiniog Town Council notes that: • The last decade has been the hottest decade ever on a global level • The level of recorded CO2 in the air is now higher than ever recorded over the last 100,000 years • That the United Nations Panel on Climate Change declared two years ago that we have only 12 years to save the world's climate • The Welsh Government has announced its intention for Wales to achieve net zero greenhouse gas emissions by 2050 • That the State of the Nature Report has revealed that one in every 6 species in Wales is in danger of extinction

		Therefore, the Town Council declares a climate and nature crisis, and agrees to form a working group to create a plan to agree how the Council can play a role in achieving net zero emissions and tackling the global downturn nature.
