Roedd y termonoleg a'i ffordd o ysgrifennu wedi creu dryswch gyda rhai aelodau, o ran capasiti chwareli llechi Ffestiniog i barhau i gloddio yn y dyfodol. ## **4. Discuss the Public Consultation Supplementary Planning Guidance:- The Slate Landscape of North-West Wales - World Heritage Site (CONSULTATION DRAFT)**

Councillor Alun Jones noted that extracts from the guidance were at risk to be misread in public. In particular points 2.5, 2.8 and 2.13 where stated,

"The continuation of the slate quarrying industry and associated activities, as an important contributor to the economy of north-west Wales and ensuring the continued supply of slate materials for the future."

And 2.8:

"Objective 7: To maintain a sustainable mineral industry.

Although primary minerals will not be mined within the World Heritage Site boundary or within the Snowdonia National Park Authority Boundary, primary and secondary mineral extraction outside the Heritage Site will be managed through the existing mineral planning process."

And then 2.13:

"Mineral Works

Although no minerals are mined within the Heritage Site boundary, active mineral extraction, tipping processing and secondary re-extraction will continue outside the boundary."

The terminology and the way it was written had created confusion with some members, as to the capacity of Ffestiniog slate quarries to continue mining in the future. It was felt that the extracts gave a false impression and did not adequately explain that the existing quarries in the Bro Ffestiniog area were outside the status boundary and therefore not affected. It was suggested that it would be beneficial to revisit this section to ensure that there is no misinterpretation in the future.

There was also a desire to stress that the guide does not hinder the future development of the slate quarrying industry, especially in an area such as Bro Ffestiniog.

Otherwise, the Council welcomed the consultation and this draft was otherwise satisfying.

**RECOMMEND:** To write to Gwynedd Council and the National Park confirming that the Town Council is content with the draft planning guidance, but would like them to revisit some sections of the guidance to ensure there is no misinterpretation in the future.
