Ystyried sefyllfa Teledu Cylch Cyfyng y dref, ac ymateb i Ebst gan PC Llinos Jones, fel a ganlyn / To consider the situation with regard to the CCTV system in town, and respond to an email from PC Llinos Jones, as follows:

Prynhawn Da,

I am sending this email in regard to the CCTV system that the town council has installed in Cromwell Street, Blaenau Ffestiniog.

We are currently having numerous 999 call's to Cromwell street, and the CCTV you have installed is very beneficial for us, thank you.

Although the only problem is, there is no means of downloading the footage on to a USB stick or retrieving the footage over a 'NICE' link. Which mean's we are having to record the footage on our cameras, the quality of the footage decreases and this could cause issues with the courts if the matter is taken further.

Could I please request that this mater is considered in the next meeting as it would provide public reassurance and safety within the community.

Annwyl Cyngor Tref Ffestiniog

Thank you for your e-mail regarding the CCTV system that you currently have in place within the town.

Even though CCTV is intrinsically linked with local police forces, under legislation local authorities have a duty to provide CCTV within towns in North Wales.

As part of my election manifesto, I committed to commission a review of how CCTV is used to combat crime between North Wales Police and the six local authorities. This review will be undertaken in due course but ahead of writing my Police and Crime Plan I am currently consulting with the public of North Wales on what my priorities should be and I urge you and as many people as possible to fill in the survey which is available on my website [North Wales Police and Crime CommissionerPublic Consultation Survey 2024 \(surveymonkey.com\)](https://www.northwalespolice.com/public-consultation-survey-2024) and which has also been distribute to all local libraries.

Neither myself or North Wales Police are in a position to take over the operation and management of CCTV in Ffestiniog but please be assured that we will be reviewing how CCTV is managed in North Wales.
